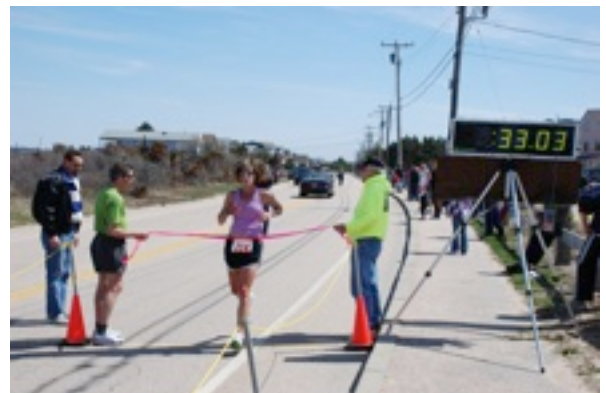
O'Neil Wins Clamdigger

Summer is Heating Up: McCoy Fun Run Series Returns for 34th Year!

For the 34th year, the Tom McCoy Fun Run Series will take place from the back parking lot at the Pleasant View Inn located at Misquamicut beach. Each run will take place every Wednesday Night beginning on June 17th. Each fun run is free to all participants; however a waiver must be signed. One signed waiver covers you for the complete series. Once again we would like to thank the Pleasant View Inn, for allowing us to use their BACK parking lot for each fun run.

Registration begins each night at 5:30 pm next to the back parking lot. A kids' fun run (3/10 loop) will take place at 6 p.m. As always, if your son or daughter completes 7 out of 10 of the fun runs, he or she will receive a FREE shirt at the end of the series.

Following the kids' fun run, adults can choose from a 1 mile, 2 mile, or 3 mile loop course. Each loop is known to be flat and fast, with a small hill thrown in at end of the second mile if you choose the 3-mile course.

In 2008, we had an average weekly attendance of just

over 110 runners. For the guys, Ryan Murdoch and Andrew McCann both took home 3 wins each in the 3-mile course while Jacob Edwards was close behind with two wins. McCann had the fastest time for the summer, running the course on August 13, 2008 in 14:28. On the women's side, Kristen Malloy was the 1st finisher six times out of the nine weeks while Laura Brustolon claimed the position the other three weeks. Malloy also had the fastest time of the summer running the course in 17:50 on July 2.

On the 10th week, a special two by mile relay was held with the team of Jacob Edwards and Matt Ridley taking home the fastest time in 9:44.

For the kids, Randi Burr won the kids loop for the girls six out of the ten times, while also clocking the fastest time of the summer in 2:04. Sarah Garvey was close behind clocking a 2:05 for the 3/10 of a mile course. On the boys' side, it was a tie between Mark Walker and Tanner LeClair each with two wins. However, Kyle Toce had the fastest time for the boys running the course in 2:07.
